



2021/2022 ANNUAL AHERA NOTIFICATION

This notice is to inform you that the Battle Creek Public School District has completed an asbestos inspection and management plan as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). The management plan has been accepted by the state of Michigan and is available for your review in the office of each school building. The management plan contains information regarding the location of asbestos containing material (ACM) in all school buildings, the condition of the ACM, and a plan for dealing the ACM.

At least once each school year, the district will inform you in a similar manner about asbestos activities, including: re-inspection, periodic surveillance, response actions, and post response action activities that are either planned or in progress.

The following asbestos related activities are currently planned or in progress for the 2021-2022 school year.

Periodic surveillance: Once every six months, ACM must be visually inspected for changes in condition. This will be performed by BCPS personnel. Our periodic surveillance will be scheduled for November 2021 and May 2022. ACM will be repaired, if damaged, and maintained by the districts Operations and Maintenance Program (O&M).

Response actions: These are the activities designed to reduce or eliminate the potential for asbestos hazards. In general, the asbestos containing materials present in school buildings are listed in each building management plan.
